I am requesting funding for the **Centerville Village Sewer Expansion Project** in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is **The Town of Barnstable**, located at **367 Main Street, Hyannis, MA 02601** The funding would be used to install approximately 5.3 miles of sewers and 6 new sewer pump station which will connect approximately 350 properties to the municipal sewer system, collect approximately 66,000 gallons per day of wastewater, and remove approximately 6.6 kg/day of nitrogen from the Centerville River Watershed .

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will enable the Town of Barnstable to address nitrogen impairment through the extension of municipal sewer within the Village of Centerville, consistent with the Town of Barnstable's Comprehensive Wastewater Management Plan (CWMP), in order to address nitrogen impairment in the Centerville River.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
