Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro:



The funding will be used for a new drinking water system for the Pine Tree Village Resident's Association, a resident-owned mobile home park.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the existing water system is sub-standard and has resulted in three non-compliance orders from the Massachusetts Department of Environment Protection in the last year alone and continued issues will result in the homes within the community becoming uninhabitable.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
