
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Bridgewater Water Expansion Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Bridgewater located at Central Square, Bridgewater, MA 02324. The Town of Bridgewater seeks funding to expand potable water capacity by constructing water lines that will join an existing interconnection point in the Town of Raynham that will allow the Town of Bridgewater to increase water capacity by one million gallons per day through a connection to the Aquaria Regional Desalination Plant. Existing restrictions on water capacity have limited the development of housing in the Town of Bridgewater and have contributed to recent water quality issues. This is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will support public health through increased access to drinking water and will allow the development of increased housing stock, including affordable housing, within the Town of Bridgewater.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1).
